The 2010-2011 LASALLIAN ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE AWARDS PROGRAM

To encourage Vietnamese students to expand their knowledge, further develop their personality, and preserve their Vietnamese culture, and at the same time, to promote the appreciation of fair competition, the Lasallian Alumni Association announces:

I. LASALLIAN ENCOURAGEMENT OF LEARNING PROGRAM

A. Academic Excellence Awards in 2010-2011 for all students in any public, private, general, or technical schools.

1. ***St. Miguel Award (\$1,000.00)***: for high school students (grades 9, 10, 11, 12)
2. ***St. Benilde Award (\$800.00)***: for middle school students (grades 6, 7, 8)
3. ***St. Mutien-Marie Award (\$500.00)***: for elementary school students (grades 3, 4, 5)

B. Criteria:

1. For students of grades 6 through 12, their report cards should have all A's or at most 2 B's for all subjects. For students of grades 3, 4, 5, their report cards should contain all O's (Outstanding) or at most 2 VG's (Very Good).
2. The student's scores of conduct and attendance must be at least S (Satisfactory).
3. The student should demonstrate good manners and correct appearance. Those students who have done volunteer works or joined youth organizations such as Boys/Girls Scouts, Buddhist Family Group, Eucharistic Youth Movement, etc... will get extra credits.
4. The student should also be able to speak, read and understand basic Vietnamese.

II. PROGRAM OF COMMENDATION FOR ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE

Besides the above awards, the program to commend excellent students has been recently established to forward the goal of encouragement to study among the Vietnamese youth. Students from all levels and grades from any public, private, general, or technical schools are eligible to apply if they meet the following requirements:

1. Academic standard:

- For students from grades 6 to 12: Straight As for all subjects during the academic year.
- For students from grade 1 to 5: straight Os for all subjects during the academic year.

2. Scores of conduct and attendance: at least S (Satisfactory)

Students who meet the above requirements will receive Certificates of Merit, Gifts, and their names are published in local newspapers.
